Spring Dairy Producer Meeting Draws Large Crowd

Last month, Jones Feed Mills hosted a dairy producer meeting at the Linwood Community Centre that saw over 100 area producers and industry personnel come out for a day of information exchange and fellowship. The meeting featured three different speakers that addressed three different industry topics.

The day started out with a talk by Meghan Potter of Virtus Nutrition (NY) on the incorporation of Omega 3 Fat into lactating diets. Meghan described the benefits Omega 3's offer through increased milk yield, as well as the positive response on reproduction. Ross Gerber later addressed the group on his experience with Omega 3's and referenced the positive results also seen with reduced SCC. Later, the crowd heard from Dr. Rob Bell of BAM who spoke on Strategic Management. Rob's usual enthusiasm and message generated a lively discussion on many of the key elements of financial management. Rob referenced the "must know" values such as return on equity and net income. Addressing the group third and on the agenda, was our own Tom Mosterd (aka The Calf Guy) who outlined critical management areas within calf rearing. Tom encouraged the crowd to review calf rearing practices as this often reveals opportunities for improvement.

Later, the tour, which consisted of a bus-load of Waterloo/Wellington area producers and a caravan of self-driving enthusiasts from Grey/Bruce/Huron counties as well as Eastern Ontario, migrated over to the Elmwood Community Centre where the owners of our hosting farms along with Dr. Ken Metzger participated in a producer panel that addresses a wide range of topics which included implanting, medication protocols, safe cattle handling and performance monitoring. The hosting partners wish to thank Steve Eby of JSE Farms, Chris Freiburger of Chimed Farms and Carl Frook of Frook Farms along with their staff & families for their time and for all of the work they all endured to host our tour group of over 100!





Colostrum Check...

As presented by Tom Mosterd at the JFM March Dairy Producer Meeting, the measurement of IgG concentration in colostrum is useful to understand the quality of your colostrum and if a supplement or additional management is required. IgG can easily be measured using a Brix Refractometer. The scale in a Brix refractometer is designed to measure the amount of sucrose in a solution, but Brix values can be related to IgG in colostrum. Jones Feed Mills offers this service to you at no-charge. Should you wish to evaluate your colostrum, speak with your JFM Dairy Sales Consultant and they can arrange for Tom to come to your farm and measure your colostrum.
