Getting the most from Your DairyComp 305 Records

DairyComp 305 is not only a useful tool for the recording on-farm herd data, it is also a great resource for your feed advisors to monitor changes on your farm. DairyComp can be used to monitor herd dynamics, production, reproduction, changes associated with feed and much more. Tracking changes through DairyComp over time is a great way to find and monitor seasonal, lactation group or management changes. For example, if production is monitored through DairyComp, and is found to be seasonally low in the summer, management strategies can be adjusted to minimize this reduction. Many farms already use DairyComp,or are on DHI (DHI uses DairyComp for their calculations), but often do not maximize the information provided by this tool. Using this information is a great way to better your management and therefore your production and profit.

The Jones Feed Mills Dairy Team uses DairyComp as a service tool and can put together reports so dairy clients can monitor production and management to ensure all animals on the farm are responding to nutrition programs appropriately. In these reports we assess herd demographics, production and reproduction. If any aspect of the report show that you are not meeting your goals, our dairy team can work with you to correct the issue. All that is needed to have a DairyComp report put together is for your farm to be on DHI or have DairyComp on farm. If you are interested in having a DairyComp report put together for your farm, talk to your JFM Dairy Sales Consultant.
