Winter Calves

Part 1 - Giving Newborn Calves the Best Start

Those first few weeks after a calf is born matter more than most people realize. How calves are managed early on has a big impact on their health, growth, and how they perform down the road. Getting the basics right early can save a lot of headaches later.

It Starts with the Cow - Late-gestation nutrition affects everything from calving ease to colostrum quality and calf vigour. Cows need enough energy, protein, minerals, and vitamins to do their job. When cows are in good shape, they tend to calve easier and produce better colostrum in those first critical hours. Strengthen your mineral program with products like BCMPLUS or BCMPPMAXB can help your cows be where they need to be.

Early Feed Makes a Difference - In cow-calf herds calving on grass, fresh pasture often helps boost milk production and gives calves a strong start. Winter-born calves don't get that benefit, so a good calf starter can go a long way. It needs to be fresh, palatable, and balanced for protein and energy to support early growth and rumen development. Putting out small amounts early helps get calves interested.

Winter calves in pens or confined feeding areas also tend to lick walls, feeders, bedding – pretty much anything they can reach. Having clean, good-quality feed available, and using medicated starters with products like Deccox® when needed, can help keep calves healthier. Products such as Jones WSC16 are designed to support calves right from the start.

Don't Skimp on Straw - Bedding matters more than people think. Deep, clean straw helps calves stay warm, saves energy, and cuts down on stress, especially in cold or wet conditions. A good rule of thumb is that calves should be able to nest into the straw so their legs are mostly covered. Dry calves are more comfortable, eat better, and usually stay healthier. In the end, good bedding and prevention are often the cheapest "medicines" you can buy.

Setting Calves Up Right - When cows are fed properly, calves get access to good feed early, and housing is comfortable, calves have a much better chance to do well. These are simple management steps, but they pay off in healthier calves and better performance as they grow.

Putting the effort in early is worth it, a good start really does make a difference.

Part 2 - Tips for Keeping your Winter Calves Happy and Healthy

Winter dairy calf care is about keeping calves warm, dry, and well-nourished. With proper bedding, protection from drafts, and adequate nutrition, calves can stay healthy and grow well even in cold conditions.

Housing & Bedding

- **Deep Bedding:** Use clean, long-stemmed straw, allowing calves to nestle down so their legs are buried for insulation.
- **The Kneel Test:** If your knees get wet after kneeling in the bedding for 20 seconds, add more.
- **No Drafts:** Ensure housing has adequate ventilation but no direct cold air hitting calves; use windbreaks if necessary.

Feeding & Hydration

- Increase Energy:** Feed more milk or milk replacer, roughly 2% more for every degree Celsius below 5°C (41°F).
- Warm Water:** Offer warm (100-105°F) water after milk feedings to encourage starter intake and digestion.
- Encourage Solids:** Provide calf starter grain early (by day 7 at the latest in a shallow dish/bowl and in small amounts to keep fresh); water intake stimulates starter consumption, generating heat.
- Warm Milk:** Feed milk replacer at body temperature (around 38.5°C) so calves don't waste energy warming it.

Extra Protection

- Calf Jackets:** Use jackets on young calves (under a month) for added insulation, but ensure they fit well and don't cause sweating.
- Colostrum:** Ensure newborns get plenty of high-quality colostrum for initial immunity and warmth.

Monitoring

- Check for Shivering:** A shivering calf is a cold calf, indicating inadequate nutrition or bedding.

A dry, well-bedded calf that's not shivering is a warm calf, so prioritize these basics for health and development. For more information please reach out to our Jones Feed Mills Dairy Team.
