Every Spring we see feeder cattle end up on pastures all across southern Ontario for backgrounding. This begs the question- "Should I be supplementing them with something more?".

When it comes to supplementing your pasture cattle you want to make it easy to do with minimal added labour. The implementation of self feeders is a real game changer that can up the performance of your grass cattle and when done correctly, won't create fleshy, undesirable cattle to buyers. Using mid level protein and high fibre pellets will add dry matter intake to your calves resulting in a higher rate of ADG. This was especially seen in summers like last year, where the grass had such high moisture content into the later summer and we didn't see it "stick to the ribs" like we normally do. The added dry fibre from pellets aids in slowing down the rumen and allowing for adequate digestion of pasture/forage within the rumen.

Maybe the more well-known benefit of self feeders is that they can aid in stretching forages during hot, dry summers when we can see a shorter grazing period. In this case, supplementing the intakes of cattle on grass will keep gains up and allow you to keep cattle on grass longer. Either way, wet or dry, self feeders have there place in an Ontario pasture situation.

The JFM products that we have seen the best success with in self feeders are HIGRO, BBGP, 1600, GSP and HFP pellets. Talk to your JFM Beef Sales Consultant about the products that may suit you best.

When looking into purchasing self feeders, some points to consider are hopper size and length in comparison to the number of cattle, how easy it is to adjust the rate in which cattle can access feed, and how easy it is to make the feeder accessible to fill from outside the pasture or move to other fields.

With cattle and land at all time high values, make sure you make the most out of your grass and increase your profits!
