
New Playground Equipment for Linwood Public School



Cleaning and Disinfecting for Calf Areas Part 1: Having a Proper Cleaning Routine for Feeding Equipment

Cleaning calf feeding equipment is something that gets overlooked very easily on farms. It takes time to clean and disinfect, and with a busy schedule on most farms, who has time? When feeding equipment doesn't get cleaned properly bacteria starts building up, which can create many problems. Whole milk or milk replacer will leave a residue behind that bacteria likes to grow in. Calf feeding equipment like bottles, pails, lids, and milk bars are some of the places where milk proteins get stuck and are a struggle to remove. When these milk proteins don't get cleaned off the calf feeding equipment, biofilms start building up. Biofilm is a slimy, greasy film of bacteria that sticks to surfaces and is pathogenic; meaning it may cause diseases in calves. The tricky part of biofilm is that it typically is resistant to conventional methods of disinfection. So, how do we get rid of this biofilm and stop the growth and spread of bacteria that our calves are coming into contact with? A product that has shown us the best results to stop the growth and build-up of bacteria is 'Biosolve Plus'. Biosolve Plus is a multipurpose heavy duty cleaner and degreaser. This product will lift the greasy proteins left behind from the milk and expose the bacteria underneath. When the bacteria is exposed, rinsing the feeding equipment with water and

appreciate the many kind comments we have received on the building's design and flow. We always welcome your visit to the office and hope to see you here sometime!


