Calves, Water and High Temperatures



Nutrition, including fresh water play an important role managing heat stress.

We have entered the time of year when temperatures rise to a point that can cause stress to animals, including young calves. One of the most important things that we can do to help calves regulate their body temperature is to ensure we keep fresh water in front of them at all times (all ages). In addition to ensuring that your calves stay hydrated, water has a linear relationship with starter intake, so not only will water help combat high temperatures, it will ensure your calves continue to take in calf starter, which is conducive to rumen development and growth.

High Temperatures and Calf Hutches

Also with higher temperatures, it is important to remember your calves out in the hutches. Calves will suffer during the peak heat hours at which point you will see a reduction in starter intake and performance. Following are two tips to keep them regulating their body temperature: First, lift the rear of the hutch up by placing a 6"x 6" underneath it which will provide air flow to the hutch. It is amazing how fast you will see your calves move to the back of the hutch where the air is flowing! Second, make sure you are using a milk replacer with a high enough protein level. A milk replacer with a protein level of 26%, like Jones WSCMR-D with Essential Lipids for life, is the best way to make sure that they continue to perform through warm weather.

Feeding the Broodmare and Foal

Proper nutrition is key for broodmares from time of conception through to weaning. A mare's nutrient requirements greatly increase during the last trimester of pregnancy - which is the most rapid stage of fetal growth. The foal will store trace minerals in its liver for use during the first few months of life. Be sure to feed a broodmare/foal specific diet to minimize the risk of developmental orthopedic disease and skeletal disorders. We encourage our customers to allow the foal to start to eat out of "mom's" dish, so they can start to get a taste of a complete feed. This will ease the stress at weaning and ensure the foal continues to eat and grow with minimal setbacks. Jones Select 16 Pellet and Jones Select One horse feeds are fortified to meet your broodmare and foal's nutrient requirements. 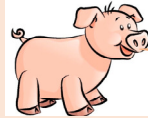
