High Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) Update

Avian Influenza (aka Bird Flu) continues to be a threat to Ontario Agriculture. Jones Feed Mills continues to take all precautions possible to help reduce the spread of the virus which includes, but is not restricted to, disinfecting all incoming supplier vehicles, disinfecting all feed delivery vehicles upon arrival on farms (in and out within perimeter zones), disinfecting all JFM sales and service vehicles when leaving farms. All personnel entering any Jones facilities must also use disinfecting foot mats to disinfect their feet before entering any JFM facility (including offices). JFM will continue to use all precautions until otherwise instructed by CFIA and Chicken Farmers Ontario.

## Skid-Wrap Reminder

JFM reminds all customers that when receiving bags on skids to **remove the shrink wrap immediately upon receipt of your order** to allow bags to breathe and prevent sweating, therefore avoiding mold and reduced feed quality. The same applies for all seasons, but this is particularly important in the warmer months.
