

From the JFM Poultry Team... Oregano as a Feed Additive

Oregano has been used medicinally for centuries for skin irritations, stomachs, nausea and as an anti-bacterial and anti-inflammatory. It has now entered the feed additive world for use in poultry production. Research has shown improved intestinal development, translating to better nutrient absorption and, ultimately, growth (Zhang et al., 2021). Oregano is also noted for its anticoccidial effects - a study using oregano leaves at 500 ppm in a broiler diet reported lower intestinal lesion scores and oocyst counts in excreta (Mohiti Asli et al., 2015). Field studies conducted by Canadian Biosystems have indicated a strong effect of their oregano based product against E.coli, Salmonella and Clostridia in broilers - this translated to improved feed conversion ratios and overall performance. Jones has integrated oregano into some of our formulas with success!

2023 Fall Dairy Outlook Considerations

On October 30th, DFO announced the addition of one incentive day for November 2023. With the shorter notice of this opportunity, it is important to have your ration in tune to maximize your milk yield potential. Early results of this year's corn silage indicate variabilities in starch. To ensure you are receiving the most from your silage, have it tested and a new ration formulated using the results.
