As corn silage harvest is near, there are considerations needed to take off corn harvest

Recommended moisture contents for corn silage are as follows:

Horizontal bunker silos	65 to 70 %
Bagged Silos	60 to 68%
Tower silos	62 to 67 %



The **silking date** can be used as an indicator to give you an estimate of timing for corn silage harvest, **usually 42 to 47 days after silking.**

The kernel milk-line has often been used to determine when to harvest corn silage. This is done by **breaking a cob in half** and looking at the kernels. **After denting (which shows as 0% milk-line), a whitish line can be seen on the kernels. This line is where the solid and liquid parts of the kernel are separated while maturing and drying.** This line will progress from the outer edge of the kernel towards the cob. When this milk-line has reached the cob (100% milk-line), a black layer is visible. The traditional recommendation has been to **harvest when the milk-line is between one-half and two-thirds.**

There is considerable variation in the percent kernel milk-line and the moisture percent of the whole plant. University of Wisconsin data over many years show a range in whole plant moisture at one-half milk-line of 52% to 72%, with an average of 63%. This will be too wet for some and much too dry for others. **The two most significant causes of the variation are weather and hybrid differences.** (Source: OMAFRA 2013)

The JFM Health and Safety Committee reminds all customers of the dangers of silo gases when filling silos this fall. Gases (nitrogen dioxide) are most prevalent for up to 60 hours after filling your silo and decrease over the following 4-6 weeks. Please remember to ensure there is proper ventilation around your silos and to wear preventative/protective equipment when working around the base of your silos. Keep all other personnel away.
